

already extending personal invitations to school-wide events and student assemblies to our Little Friends of Grace, Grace Lutheran Preschool families. We are also working on a student partnership reading program

with the community's preschool administrators to build connections and relationships with our potential future students.

Additionally, I am working closely with the CLS Board of Trustees and committees to utilize our financial resources wisely and to the fullest potential. This is being accomplished through renegotiating deals and services of utilities, copier/ printing services, etc. to be better stewards of the gifts we are given. The school is also focused on forward movement in implementing the school's new Technology Strategic Plan, while maintaining the same commitment to cost savings. By improving the school's technology infrastructure, we will be better able to meet the educational and technological needs of our students as we strive toward academic excellence.
