

Family Parent Partnership (FPP) Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Karin Ross. There were 17 parents in attendance along with Mrs. Linda Billig and Mrs. Penny Segessenman. Mrs. Ross led the group in the Pledge of Alliance and Mrs. Billig said the prayer.

The minutes from the January 4, 2017 minutes were presented with Taryn Plendel making the motion to approve and the second was given by Terry Bergevin. All in attendance were in favor and the minutes stand as presented. The treasurer's report was presented in detail by Treasurer Kristy Dean.
