

## **Family Parent Partnership (FPP) Meeting**

**Carroll Lutheran School ~ Wednesday, March 8, 2017**

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Karin Ross. There were 16 parents in attendance along with Mrs. Mandy Gilbert. Mrs. Ross led the group in the Pledge of Alliance and Mrs. Gilbert said the prayer.

The minutes from the February 1, 2017 meeting were presented with Leslie Caperton making the motion to approve and the second was given by Becki Gray. All in attendance were in favor and the minutes stand as presented. The treasurer's report was presented in detail by Treasurer Kristy Dean. Sharon Scholze made the motion to accept the treasurer's report and Mandy Gilbert gave the second, all in attendance were in favor and the report stands as presented.

Mrs. Gilbert gave the Administrator's Report. She explained that there no longer would be a large fee for the One Call as Ren Web offered the same program for a cost of only \$29.00 a year. We will begin using the Ren Web one call system in September. Because of that reduction in costs, which the FPP paid, Mrs. Gilbert is asking the FPP to consider a request for cabinets in the cafeteria, to line the walls on either side. This will add some much needed storage space as well as give a more appealing look to the room. Further discussion on this will be held at the next meeting. Mrs. Gilbert also noted that this year Field Day would be an all-day affair. There will be water games, team games plus food prepared by Nancy Weller. She and Mrs. Billig wanted to give Field Day a "facelift". Also noted was that information on Conferences has been sent out to parents. Parents now have the option of a phone call conference as well as an in person one. More information on conferences will be coming home shortly. Mrs. Gilbert said that they were on a "purging streak". Many items have been given to the school that are no longer needed and they want to give them to someone who can use them and by doing so, they are created space for items that we do need to store. With the school continuing to grow, it is hoped that one day in the future, there can be a portable building for the "specials" teachers. Mrs. Gilbert also suggested that a bulleted highlight of the FPP meetings be sent out to parents. Kristy Dean will take care of that.

Kristy Dean went over the proceeds, in detail, of the recent consignment sale. The net profit from the sale was \$6,141.79. Also noted - Alpha Pregnancy vouchers were \$2,275.00 and there was a truck full of items donated to Second Chance. Kristy said that there will be a debriefing meeting soon to discuss what works well and what doesn't for the next consignment sale.

Nancy Baker told the group that the LuLaRoe sale netted a total of \$369.50; \$250.00 coming from the consigners and \$119.50 from the food sales. This money will go toward defraying the cost of Outdoor School.

Mrs. Ross read a proposal for mulch brought in by Becki Gray from her uncle's landscaping business. The mulch, 115 yards, can be delivered to the edge of the playground for a cost of \$2430.00. A brief discussion was held regarding the spreading of the mulch. Kendal Sewell made the motion to accept this bid and Steve Bell seconded the motion, all in attendance were in favor and the motion carried. Mrs. Gilbert said she felt the middle schoolers could help with the spreading, they could dress down and earn service hours for their help. Genetta Miller will talk to her husband regarding his help with a bob-cat. A date and time for the mulch will be announced.

Kristy Dean informed the group that there still is a need for a lot of help with the Bingo. She encouraged everyone to use the Sign Up Genius to volunteer. As of today, the ticket sales were at 125 and she is hopeful for a sale of 200. She also noted that on Friday, March 17, 2017 at 3pm, middle schoolers can help with set up and will earn service hours. Kristy noted that 40 eight foot tables have been rented from Ben's Rentals. Baskets are coming along nicely and there will be a silent auction held at the bingo with sports memorabilia along with other items.

Kristy Dean reminded everyone of the next Restaurant fund raiser to be held on Monday, March 20<sup>th</sup> at Panera from 6pm to 9pm.

Upcoming Dates – Sky Dome presentation on March 21, 2017. Elementary show will be held at 9am and Middle School show at 10am. Parents are welcome to attend. Book Fair week is April 3rd to April 7th. Family Fun night will be held on Thursday, April 6<sup>th</sup> – look for details coming out in a flyer shortly. Teacher Appreciation Week will be held May 8<sup>th</sup> to May 12<sup>th</sup>. Slime Night for K through 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be held on Friday, May 12<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 to 8pm.

With no further business in front of the group, Kendal Sewell made a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded by Julie Keller. The next meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 4, 2017. The meeting concluded with the Lord's Prayer said in unison.
