April 4, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 6:38 PM by Kristy Dean.

16 people were in attendance (parents, teachers, staff, board members).

Review & Approval of March Meeting Minutes:

President's Report:

- Kristy Dean presented the President's report:

- Spring Bingo –
 - BIG THANK YOU to everyone who assisted and especially to Cindy Myers and Liliya Seipp for coordinating!
 - Financial update presented by Genetta Miller:
 - Total net profit of \$12,972.90 – see summary below.
 - Minimal expenses since so much was donated.
 - Total proceeds almost covered earnings from both bingo and consignment sale in 2017.
 - Feedback on bingo was solicited from the FPP attendees. Comments/suggestions include:
 - Have more bingo game cards for next year to sell
 - Would be easier to have someone coordinate all the kitchen/food separately from the person coordinating the bingo

- Setup a committee to divide up the tasks for bingo more so the work is spread out more. Have committee meetings to coordinate everything.
- Create a binder of instructions for doing bingo in future years.
- Do reserved seating on just one side of the gym so folks without reserved seating can easily find places to sit.
- SpiritWear – update from Cynthia Myers – all Spiritwear was delivered and second order has been submitted also. We should get 2nd order back next week. Minimum order is 12 items each time. Sold 73 items the first time around; 14 additional items ordered in 2nd batch of orders.
- Tristar Martial Arts Presentation – self-defense seminar. We will schedule this for next fall due to the busy schedule thru the end of the year.
- Skating Parties – April 15th – Magic Elm Skateland – 4:30 pm – 7 pm. Admission free, skate rental is \$3. Bring anyone and everyone!
- Family Business Directory Update – Will be completed shortly by Kristy Dean.
- Fun Run – May 4, 2018 (afternoon after lunch) – update from Beth King
 - School-wide celebration event of health & wellness; less focus on fundraising now.
 - Beth is coordinating the Fun Run portion; Kristy Dean is coordinating the fundraising aspect of it.
 - Beth needs volunteers to help with the Fun Run as very few people have volunteered for it. Volunteers are needed to help mid-late morning on May 4th to setup (balloons, flags, etc.) and volunteers to help after 12:45 pm to assist teachers/students with where to go and what to do. Cleanup volunteers also needed to pickup everything.
 - Donations of snacks & fruit will be requested later.
 - There may be a reward/competition component to the Fun Run to end the day afterwards with the faculty.
 - The main focus for the kids is on setting goals, health & wellness.
 - Per Kristy, we want to determine what the funds from this will be used for. Suggestions have been a gaga ball pit, a new volleyball net, another section of swing set, tetherballs, etc. Students need to understand what they are working towards for fundraising. We will also have an incentive program again by individual (similar to what was done for the sub sale). We will try to use electronic and manual fundraising efforts so funds can be sourced from out of state friends/family. Various online programs are available to do this and will be reviewed soon by Kristy.
 - Beth will be doing a big promotion of the event with the kids starting next week.
 - Beth will work on a “rain plan” in the event of bad weather.
 - Everyone will have a ‘buddy’ for the event to cheer each other on. Please have family come to cheer the kids on!
 - In the future, we will move this to a fall event and then build it out to be a bigger 2nd fundraiser for the FPP.
- FPP Board Positions for 2018/19 school year – All current board members are staying on, but other folks are encouraged to be members at large. Please let us know if you’d like to come join us.
