


Dear Friends of CLS.

CLS Parent Letter from Lauren Bukszar.

Our family joined the CLS community when our oldest son Henry started kindergarten for the 2020-2021 academic year. Prior to that, I had substituted at CLS and found myself in awe with the level of love and thoughtfulness that went into substitute lesson plans. My experience as a substitute told me everything I needed to know prior to enrolling our child.

The following school year, we moved 30 minutes away and made the difficult decision to withdraw Henry so that he could attend school closer to our new home. We tried to remain positive as a family, but it was impossible not to compare everything to CLS. We did not have an unusually bad experience at the new school; it simply wasn't CLS. From the warm greetings during morning drop-off, the exceptional leadership and staff, the faith-based values and overall feeling of community, we realized not every school is like CLS. I contacted Mrs. Gilbart over Christmas break to see if we could re-enroll Henry. We feel so blessed that it worked out, and no one was more excited than Henry. Having grown up in the Baltimore independent school community and having worked in both independent and public schools as an admissions coordinator and teacher, I have seen a variety of school cultures and CLS is truly a special place.

We humbly share our story with other families that ask us about our experience at CLS. As a big family, we are frequently asked about our morning routine, the commute, tuition, etc., and our response is simple: CLS is worth it.
