Tuesday, November 11 – **Veterans Day** – Wear Red/White and/or Blue Shirt
 (with school uniform pants)
Tuesday, November 25 – Favorite Outfit (Thanksgiving Break Begins)
Thursday & Friday, December 18, & 19
 Wear Christmas Colors (last days before Christmas Break)
Friday, January 23 – Favorite Outfit
Friday, February 13 – Valentine's Day Colors – suitable for PE
Tuesday, March 17 – St. Patrick's Day – Wear Green Shirts
 (with school uniform pants)
Tuesday, March 31 – Favorite Outfit (Easter Break Begins)
April 27 – May 1– Spirit Week (more information will be sent out)
Friday, May 22 – Wear Red, White and/or Blue
Friday, June 5 – Favorite Outfit (Sunday Best-No Denim) – Last Day School

Note: Students choosing not to dress down in the designated theme should wear their regular school uniform.

Important Note: If dress down clothing, including shoes, does not meet the appropriate guidelines, we will contact the parent/guardian to bring a change of clothes.

Dress Down Day – Dress Code

APPROPRIATE	NOT APPROPRIATE
Jeans, sweatpants, or school uniform pants	Spandex, yoga pants, pajama pants, pants with holes/rips, and tight-fitting pants
Shorts may only be worn until October 31st and after April 1st <i>No shorter than 2" above the knee</i>	Short shorts, spandex, yoga shorts, holes/rips, and tight-fitting shorts <i>Short length must be the same length as the uniform shorts.</i>
Dresses or skirts *Leggings/tights/knee socks should be worn November 1st thru March 31st <i>No shorter than 2" above the knee</i>	Short dresses and short skirts. <i>Dress/skirt length must be the same length as the uniform dress or skirt.</i>
Polo-style shirts, T-shirts, button shirts, sweaters, sports jerseys, or sweatshirts	Tank tops, sleeveless tops, strapless, offensive graphics and/or slogans
School shoes, sneakers, "Ugg"-style boots, and other flat shoes or boots	Sandals, Crocs, flip-flops, cowboy-style boots, high-heels (greater than approx. ½ inch), open toe and/or open heels
Socks of any color/length	Offensive graphics or slogans
	Hats, masks, etc. (unless specified for the special occasion). Hair colors (red, blue, green, etc.)

***Leggings:** Students must wear a dress, skirt, or long tunic top over their leggings. The tunic top or shirt that is worn over a pair of leggings must be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
